



The French Reproducible Research Network is an informal national initiative engaging scientists to promote research reproducibility.






Figure 1: (A)

The network brings together 260 members from 23 diverse fields (Fig. 1A) across 13 french regions (Fig.1B), covering almost all the french territory. With its transdisciplinary approach, it promotes collaboration and knowledge exchange across disciplines throughout France.


Actions
