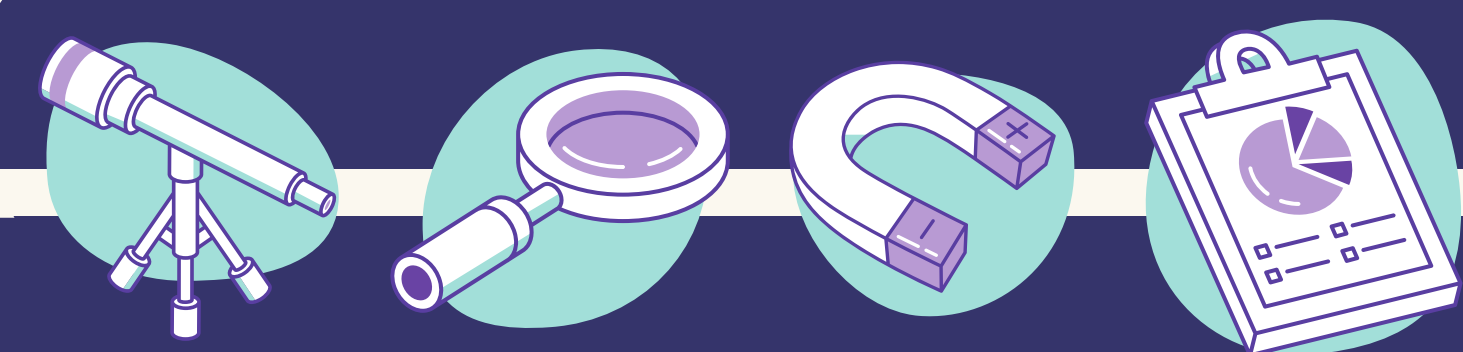

The network

The **French Reproducible Research Network** is an informal national initiative engaging scientists to promote **research reproducibility**.

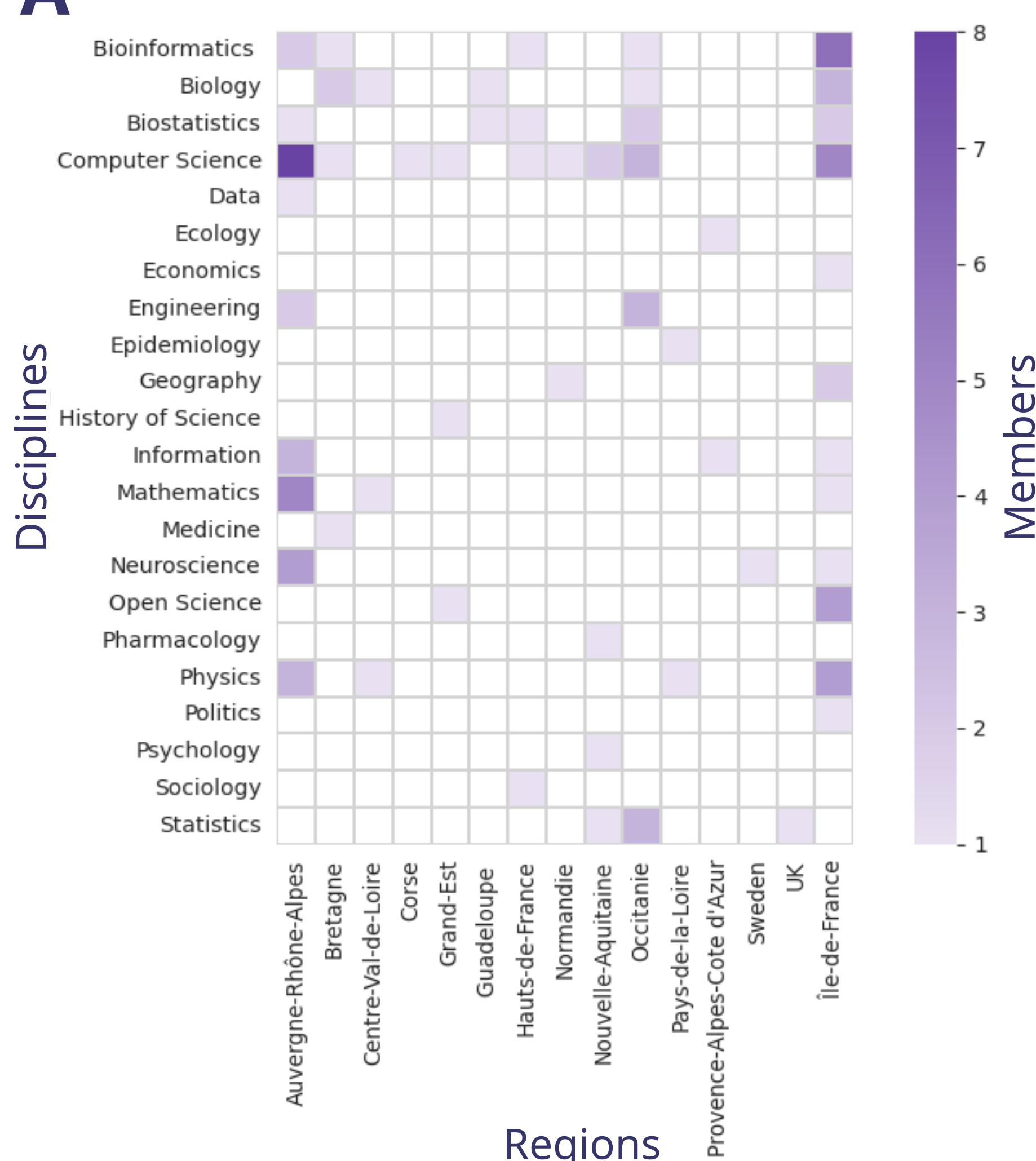


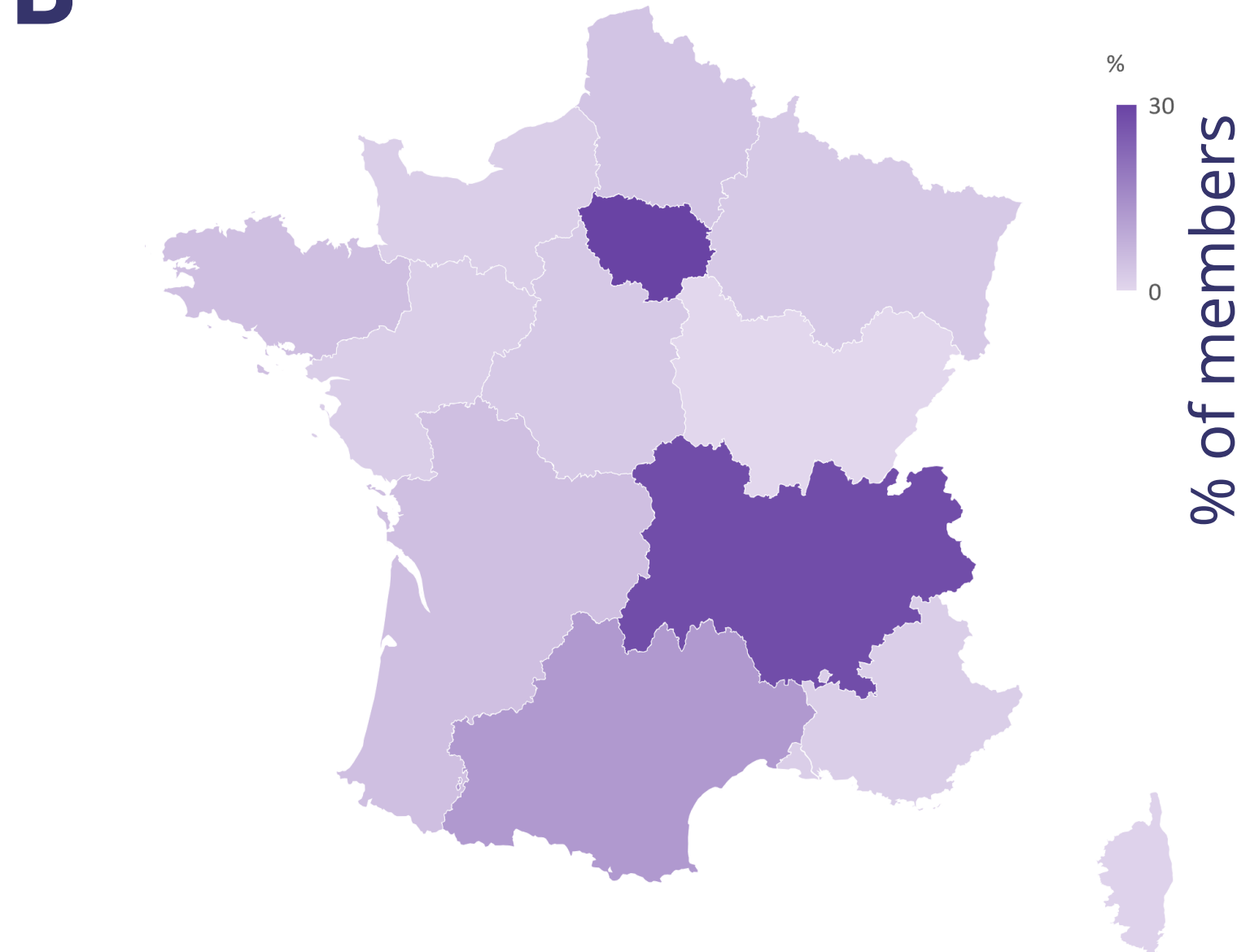
Figure 1: (A)

The network brings together **260 members** from **23 diverse fields** (Fig. 1A) across **13 french regions** (Fig.1B), covering almost all the french territory. With its **transdisciplinary approach**, it promotes **collaboration** and **knowledge exchange** across disciplines throughout France.

A Distribution of disciplines across the territory

B Members in Metropolitan France

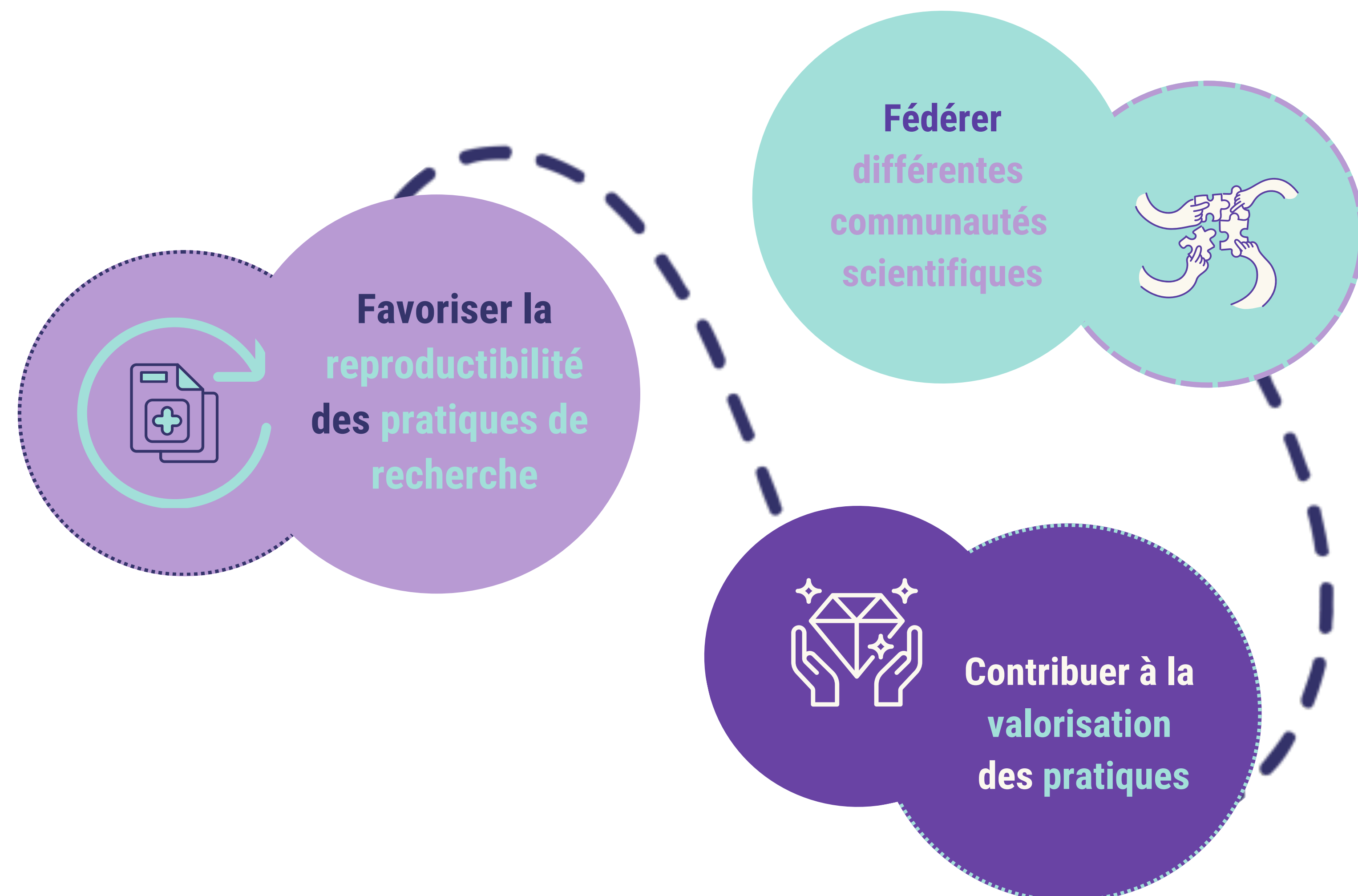


Structure

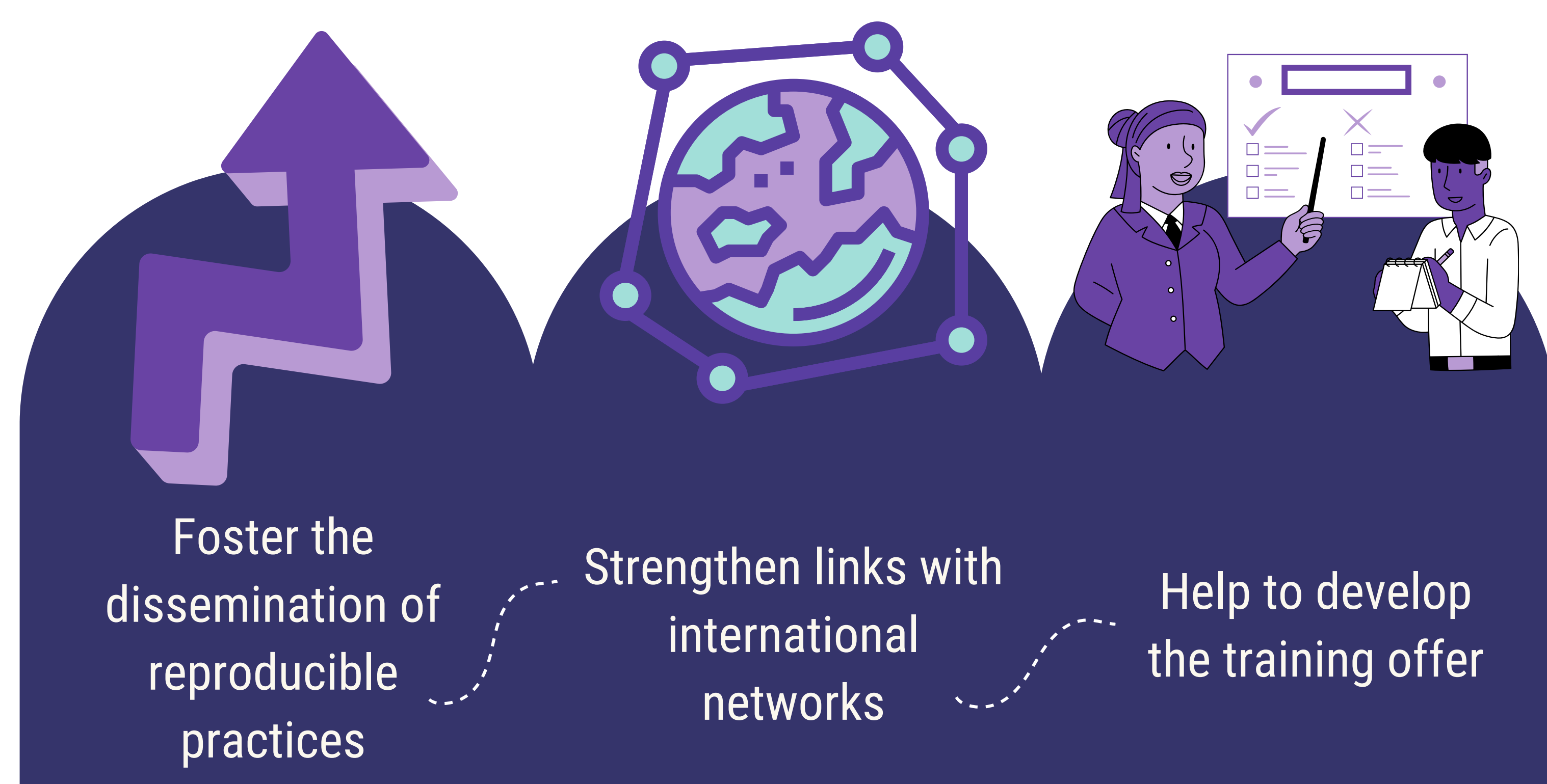
The network has established a structure with three components:

- A **steering committee** that defines priority areas and coordinates various actions,
- **Cross-cutting committees** (community engagement, European relations, institutional relations),
- **Working Groups** focused on specific topics (training, notebooks, software environment management).
