The aim of the network is therefore to achieve broad and diversified disciplinary representation.


It currently has around 260 members on its mailing list, from at least 30 different disciplines, a fundamental element in the exchange of good interdisciplinary practice.

Structure

To fulfil these goals, the network has set up a structure with **3 types of components**:

- A steering Committee, which defines the priorities and coordinates the various actions,
- Cross-disciplinary colleges (scientific events, european relations, institutional relations).
- Work groups on specific topics (training, notebooks, software environment management).
